## **RE: New Waterline Construction in Ohio Street and Oriente Drive**

Dear Resident:

The Yorba Linda Water District (YLWD) will be replacing aging waterlines in Ohio Street north of Yorba Linda Boulevard to the terminus of Ohio Street, and in Oriente Drive from Lakeview Avenue to Ohio Street. The existing waterlines vary in age from approximately 70 to 85 years, and require replacement in order to continue to provide quality water service to you and your neighbors. A vicinity map showing the local area and the pipelines being replaced is provided on the back of this letter.

Currently, we anticipate this work to take place late spring through early summer 2011.

Please be advised, installation of the new waterlines will require temporary closure of small sections of Ohio Street from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., weekdays, due to the narrow nature of this street. Note that each sectional closure will only be during those mid-day hours and for the time period necessary to complete pipe installation in that section.

Pipeline replacement work in Oriente Drive will only require street closure at the Ohio Street intersection because it is generally wider, in comparison with Ohio Street. Be aware that if your street outlets onto Ohio Street or Oriente Avenue, your access may be impacted by the project.

**Please note, at 6:30 p.m. Thursday January 20, 2011, YLWD will conduct a public meeting at District headquarters, 1717 East Miraloma Avenue, Placentia CA 92870.** At the meeting, we will make a short presentation and provide more details on the planned project. You are invited to attend this meeting, ask questions, and express any concerns you may have. If you are unable to attend, more information will be provided as the project construction draws closer, currently expected late spring to early summer 2011. We will provide you with information on who to contact with questions and a Hot Line for your calls.

We recognize that construction is an inconvenience to residents and we greatly appreciate your patience and understanding regarding this matter. If you have questions in the interim, please contact Mr. Anthony Manzano, Senior Project Manager, at 714-701-3106.
