PUBLIC NOTICE

The Yorba Linda Water District (YLWD) would like to confirm with residents that neither Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MET) nor the YLWD **endorse** any company to install weather-based irrigation controller products.

Recently the YLWD received a call from a customer who also happens to live in East Lake, about a call that she received from a local company. This company claimed that they were able to install a weather-based irrigation controller for the customer that was 100% rebated and they, as a company, were endorsed both by the MET and the Yorba Linda Water District. The customer was unsure of the claim and called YLWD to verify.

Again, while the YLWD does not endorse any company, they do encourage customers to install the products, as they are extremely water efficient. Individual homeowners may also choose to do the installation themselves.

The rebates offered by MET are currently available at \$60 per station. This amount may not cover the full cost of the controller, depending upon the type of controller purchased and *funding is limited*. This rebate, if available, must also be paid to the homeowner directly. A company cannot claim to do the work for “free” and then receive the rebate check as “payment”.
